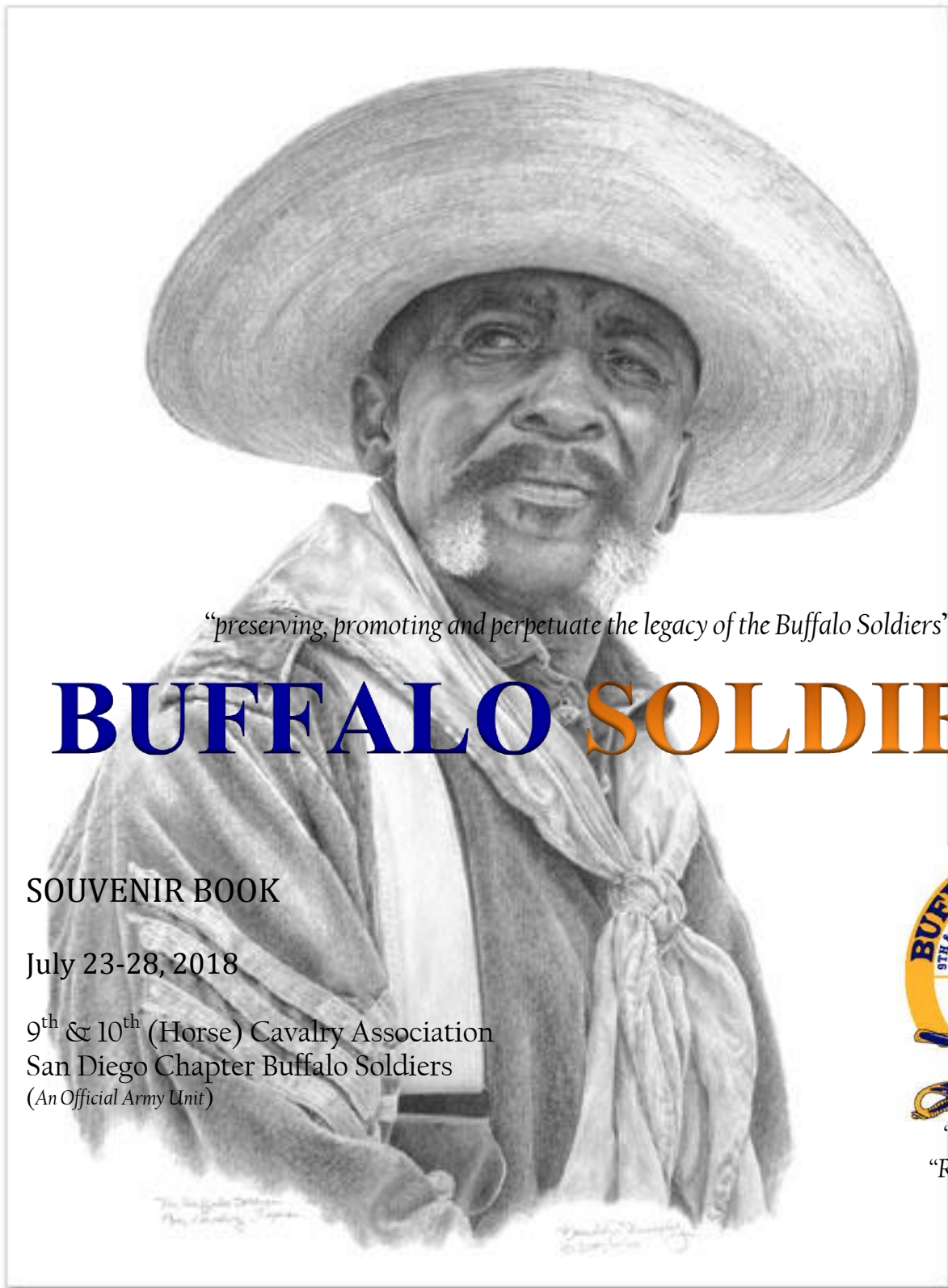

USS MIDWAY - The USS Midway



was America's longest-serving aircraft carrier of the 20th century, from 1945 to 1992. Approximately 200,000 sailors served aboard the carrier, known for several naval aviation breakthroughs as well as several humanitarian missions. It was the only carrier to serve the entire length of the Cold War and beyond. It is now berthed in San Diego, the original home of the Navy's TOPGUN fighter school.

24<sup>th</sup> INFANTRY The 24th Infantry Division was among the first US Army divisions to see combat in World War II and among the last to stop fighting. Come learn about the 24<sup>th</sup> Infantry, see original pictures and share stories.



VETERANS MUSEUM - The Veterans Museum at Balboa Park is one of the very few places you will find that covers all branches of the service and is indeed a home for all veteran groups. Take a moment to view a sampling of the Museum. The Veterans Museum at Balboa Park occupies the former chapel of the Naval Hospital on Inspiration Point in San Diego's Balboa Park. The original hospital buildings have been a familiar and nostalgic landmark to countless naval personnel and San Diegans alike since the early 1920s, although the chapel itself was not built and completed until January 1945. Today the Museum houses a unique collection of artifacts, memorabilia, artwork and papers as well as a Military History Reference library holding more than eleven thousand volumes. Dedicated to veterans of all conflicts, the Museum's Memorabilia & Exhibits feature World War I, World War II, Pearl Harbor, the Korean War, Vietnam, Desert Storm, Women in the Military, and paintings by local artists of military subjects.



**VIEJAS CASINO** - San Diego casino hotel visitors will love our modern amenities, streamlined design and handcrafted, boutique feel. With the opening of our second luxury hotel tower on October 30, 2015, Viejas has taken the next step in our ongoing property refinement, raising the level of luxury to a new height!



**SAN DIEGO ZOO** - The San Diego Zoo is a zoo in Balboa Park, San Diego, California, housing over 3,700 animals of more than 650 species and subspecies.<sup>[1]</sup> Its parent organization, San Diego Zoo Global, is one of the largest zoological membership associations in the world, with more than 250,000 member households and 130,000 child memberships, representing more than a half million people.<sup>[6]</sup> The San Diego Zoo was a pioneer in the concept of open-air, cageless Memorabilia & Exhibits that re-create natural animal habitats.<sup>[7]</sup> It is one of the few zoos in the world that houses and successfully breeds the giant panda.<sup>[8]</sup> In 2013, the zoo added a new Koalafornia Adventure

Memorabilia & Exhibit, providing an updated Australian animal experience.

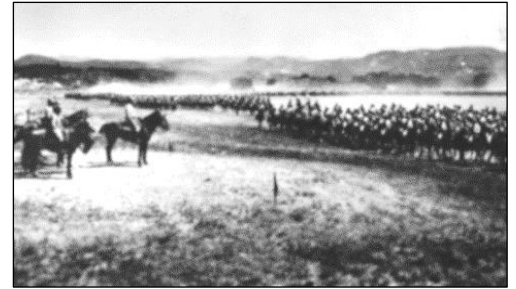

**CABRILLO MONUMENT** Cabrillo National Monument offers a superb view of San Diego's harbor and skyline and includes Old Point Loma Lighthouse, a San Diego icon since 1854. As for the history of this remarkable monument: On September 28, 1542, Juan Rodriguez Cabrillo landed at San Diego Bay. This event marked the first time that a European expedition had set foot on what later became the west coast of the United States. His Accomplishments were memorialized

on October 14, 1913 with the establishment of Cabrillo National Monument.



**CAMP LOCKETT** was a United States Army military base located in Campo, California, east of San Diego, and north of the Mexican border. Camp Lockett has historical connections to the Buffalo Soldiers due to the 10th and 28th Cavalry Regiments having been garrisoned there during World War II.



**BAHIA BELLE STEAMBOAT** Our classic sternwheeler, the Bahia Belle, provides complimentary family-hour and cocktail cruises on Mission Bay for our valued guests. Our 74-foot, 3-story sternwheeler offers an observation deck to view the beautiful sites of the 4,200-acre aquatic park, and is the perfect venue to relax and unwind at the end of the day. ### MUSEUM CASA DE REY MORRO

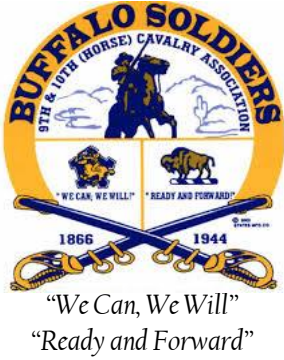

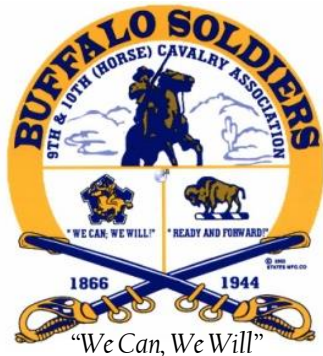
