Under the provisions of par. 12 a (1)(b) 1, AR 260-10, battle participation credits and battle honors for the headquarters of brigades, divisions, and higher units are determined upon the merits of each case. If the headquarters of a brigade or higher unit actually functioned as such in the direction and control of a combat operation, this Section recommends that it be awarded appropriate credits and honors. A case in point is covered by 11th Indorsement, Historical Section, A.W.C., May 4, 1928, to The Adjutant General concerning Headquarters, 28th Division. Request is hereby made for War Department approval of this basis for determination of these cases.

3. It is further requested that this letter, with the action of the War Department thereon, be forwarded through the Chief of the Militia Bureau to the Adjutant General of Maryland; and that this Section be informed as to the action taken.
